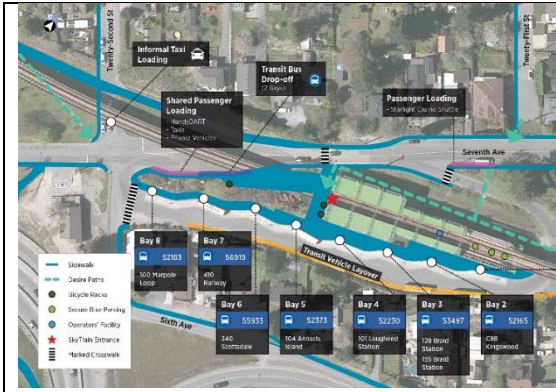

22nd Street Station Area Transportation Study City of New Westminster (2018-2019)

WATT is working with the City, TransLink, and other public agencies to create a new vision for the 22 Street SkyTrain station area, drawing on a broad range of bold new ideas. Instead of relying only on the traditional method of preparing traffic models and specifying capacity upgrades, we worked with experts and stakeholders in a collaborative charrette format to create a robust transportation concept for the future that accommodates unknown development timelines and emerging mobility options.



Highland Boulevard Cycling Facility Design District of North Vancouver (2017)

We developed the interim and final designs for buffered bike lanes and accompanying pavement marking and signage plan for Highland Boulevard in North Vancouver. We drew on our expertise in bicycle planning and design based on our 2012 update of TAC's Bikeway Traffic Control Guidelines for Canada and our involvement in numerous AT plans throughout BC.
